Please know that what you are doing will make a difference as 100% of the money raised from the event will go towards charity. Hope you have fun!

Rules:

- You may compete either as an individual or a team in all categories.
- Cupcakes must be made in advance.
- You will be expected to create 48 cupcakes using one design on all of them set to a specific theme of your choice. (Ideas: fall, cars, football, Halloween, etc.)
- (12) Cupcakes must be displayed on a card table or a display close to that size, the rest are going to be up for sale right away. Feel free to be creative. (Example: Use a tropical theme and put a grass skirt around the table, hang up a palm tree, serve the cakes on a platter that looks like a surfboard.) Get the idea!
- Displays **MUST** be set up by 1:00.
- Boxed cake mixes are NOT allowed.
- You will be judged on display, design of the cupcake and taste.
 - For the taste category 80% of the scoring in this category is taste, design and display will count for 20%.
- A standard cupcake size is required. (not mini or jumbo)

General Information:

- During judging no one will be allowed in by the tables. The judges will come around to the tables to view the display and randomly choose a cupcake from the display for tasting.
- At 2:30 prizes will be awarded. There will be a first, second, and third place for each category.
- The remaining cupcakes in your display will be sold to the public after the awards with 100% of the money raised going to the charity chosen.
- Once again we will have a People's Choice Award voted on by the public.
- Concession will be available from 9am to 4pm (doughnuts, coffee, pizza, nachos, pop, etc.)
- PTO will also have a craft sale in the Middle School gym at the same time.
