Personnel

- a. Elections— The official election results were shared and the Oath of Office took place.
- b. Staff Resignations/Retirements
 1. Mrs. Tammy Kornack submitted her letter of retirement. After 35 years in education, 12 of which were in Edgar, Tammy has decided to take time to spend with family. The School Board approved.
- c. Staff Hires
 1. Mr. Adam Decker applied for the part-time AD position. We interviewed Adam and feel he will be a good fit for this position. We were able to work time into his current schedule to allow for AD responsibilities. The School Board approved.
- d. 2026-27 Teacher Contracts—I recommend approval of the Teacher Contracts for 2026-27. Again, this year, due to our compensation plan, we will need to put current year's salary on the contracts. Once each staff member completes their end of year meeting with the building level principals to determine their Educator Effectiveness rating then I will prepare an addendum to the contracts that will again need to be approved by the Board. - e. Co-Curricular Coach Hire
 1. Ms. Sydney Busche is interested in assisting with MS Softball Coach. The School Board approved.

Policy

- a. Policy #8505: Food Service Collection—2nd Reading: This policy needed to be updated to meet the requirements of the Administrative Review in our Food Service. I made the change that was recommended at the March Board meeting under the section titled: Insufficient Account Status Notification Process "B." The School Board approved for 2nd Reading.
- b. Neola Policy Special Update—Act 57 2nd Reading: Policy #8462: Child Abuse and Neglect. This policy was updated to comply with WI Act 57. There were no changes from the March Board meeting. The School Board approved for 2nd Reading.
