Bryce Kolpack is currently the Associate Dean of the Public Safety Division at Northcentral Technical College, Wausau, WI. He is responsible for the administration of Criminal Justice, Fire and Emergency Medical Services training as well as the Director of the NTC Law Enforcement Academy.
