Personnel

1. Staff Resignation: Bookkeeper
 - a. Mrs. Morgan Mueller has submitted her letter of resignation as district bookkeeper with her last day being June 30, 2026. The School Board approved.
2. Spring Coaches
 - a. The School Board approved the assistant coaches for track, baseball, and softball.
3. Additional Wrestling Coach
 - a. With the start of the 2025-2026 Wrestling Season, the program has grown to 33 high school student athletes, and 12 middle school student athletes. This year has also brought a change in Wisconsin High School wrestling to include female only events. With the growing numbers of student athletes, the added wrestling events to schedule, and the larger load of administrative duties in managing the boys' and girls' events we recommended that we hire an additional assistant wrestling coach. The School Board approved.
