Policy

a. Policy #5113: Open Enrollment Program—determining annual capacity/space for Regular Education and Special Education: According to DPI Open Enrollment guidelines, school districts should establish the number of Regular and Special Education open enrollment spaces annually in January. MCSE has prepared three options for our district to evaluate. I recommended we follow the current practice for open enrollment so that the school district of Edgar has unlimited space available per regular education pupil for grades PreK-12. I also recommended that we limit the space available per special education pupil for grades PreK-12 utilizing the following:

Utilize the capacity/student enrollment **only** calculation. It is recommended that students with disabilities be considered for open enrollment preference if they have siblings already attending the district. The preference would be permitted if the district has the program and services listed in the IEP.
