

EDGAR ALUMNI HALL OF FAME



SELECTION CRITERIA:

- 1) Nominees must have demonstrated or accomplished significant contributions(s) in at least one of the following areas:



**BUSINESS / JOB RELATED / CAREER ADVANCEMENT
COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP
EDUCATION
SERVICE**

- 2) Nominees must hold a diploma signifying graduation from Edgar High School.
- 3) Nominees must have graduated at least ten (10) years prior to nomination.

NOMINATION PROCEDURE:

- 1) Anyone (family, friend, self, ...) may nominate an alumni by submitting a written testimonial or nomination form to the Edgar High School principals office, which addresses the above criteria. Two current photographs should accompany the nomination information.
- 2) A maximum of three (3) nominees will be inducted into the Hall of Fame each year. Nominees who are not selected will automatically be carried over for five (5) years beyond the date of their nomination.
- 3) Each year, all nominations will be due by May 15th. Nomination forms are available in the High School office or on the District website: www.edgar.k12.wi.us Selections will be made by June 30th.



SELECTION COMMITTEE:

The selection committee shall consist of all interested past inductees to the Hall of Fame, the Edgar High School Principal, and faculty member.

LOCATION OF THE HALL OF FAME:

The Edgar Alumni Hall of Fame will be proudly on display at the high school entrance to the Library Media Center.
