Mrs. Sandra (Szymanski) Lepak was a hard working farmer's wife and homemaker who left her lab technician job in 1969 to take care of her growing family. She was a CCD Instructor at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in the town of Cassel for 10 years.

Mrs. Lepak worked at the former Stahmer Clinic and the former St. Mary's Hospital, both in Wausau as a lab technician.

Due to her dedication to Pro-Life, Mrs. Lepak organized and became the head cook for a Pro-Life Chili Dinner for 25 years. She impacted people's lives and the unborn locally as well as around the country and in Rome at Vatican City. Because of this service the Wisconsin Right to Life has created the *Sandra Lepak Youth Pro-Life Leadership Fund* which is used to send youth as young as 13 to leadership camps during the summer.

Sandra Lepak was married to Kenneth Lepak and they had six children- Sally, Jane, Ronald, Joe, Gerald & Anne, as well as 23 grandchildren. Mrs. Lepak died April 9, 2010 in a traffic accident.
